What have we been up to?

Third General Assembly: Policy Amendments



As you might have already heard, this association year we will have an additional General Assembly which will help to professionalise Caerus. Due to the Corona Crisis, this year we have not been able to focus too much on acitivies and events. Therefore, we have been looking more into Caerus' rules and regulations such as the Caerus Policy Manual.

At the upcoming General Assembly we would like to vote on these policies that we have been working on so hard. To get a bit of an insight, these policies include a framework for honorary members of Caerus as well as policies about environmental sustainability within Caerus.

We are in regular contact with the Advisory Council in order to make our suggested policies as clear as possible. Thank you to the Advisory Council for all your work on reviewing our policies!

The Caerus Board is looking forward to presenting and discussing these policies with you at this next General Assembly.

During the last weeks, the Caerus Board has been working on updating the Privacy Policy. Currently, it's rather outdated and we feel like it is important that documents like these are precise and accurate. As you may all know, we are no legal professionals but we have asked for help from the faculty. They have recently hired a new Privacy & Security Coordinator, Francien Broekhans, who has offered to help us out. We have already had a first meeting with her and received some valuable advice. We hope to present the updated Privacy Policy at the next General Assembly.



Despite mentioning it in our Policy Plan, we have decided to not apply for the Internationalisation Grant this year. Next to being overwhelmed with our uni work, as well as other board tasks, we believed our ideas were not concrete enough to apply.

One idea we had it to use the Internationalisation Grant for the 'Language Cafe' or another similar concept. An example of this would be having some Dutch lessons to help incoming international students get familiar with the language. We hope that the next Caerus Board can make these ideas more concrete in collaboration with our committees and then successfully apply for the Internationalisation Grant!





If you have not already heard the fantastic news at our General Assembly and the previous newsletter, then here it is again: Our Green Subsidy Application has been approved by the Green Office Groningen. In our proposal we suggested that Caerus could have its own garden to grow flowers, food and herbs for its own Caerus events. Furthermore, we would like to teach Caerus members a certain way of storing food, called "wacking". The full proposal has been approved which means that we will get refunded an amount of 431,95€ for gardening equipment and preservation material. We aim to slowly get started with the garden in Block 4 with a Gardening Team and then fully start of the Caerus Garden after the summer. We can then transform the Gardening team into a committee. Below you will find the assessment of your application.

• **Approved** - Garden material worth €267,95

We really like the idea of setting up your own garden. Garden material is definitely necessary to start this garden.

Approved - Gardening equipment worth €88,10

Similar to above, you do need these materials to maintain the garden. We highly recommend you try and get the equipment second hand. Second-hand equipment is more sustainable in every way and is probably even cheaper as well.

Approved - Harvest preservation containers worth €75,90

We support this idea as well. In order to avoid waste sometimes the harvest needs to be preserved in such containers. Avoiding waste is always a good sustainable goal.

UCSRN Online Tournament




The UCSRN Tournament is back! "Unifying all University Colleges of the Netherland."


